'LHM SUNDAY' PLANNING CHECKLIST

- ❑ **All:** Review the tips.
- ❑ **Pastor:** Call your Ambassador to discuss and coordinate plans for marking LHM Sunday. If your church does not have an Ambassador, please enlist a volunteer to present, or if you prefer, present the information yourself.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Ask your pastor/elder for permission to hold **LHM Sunday**, show the **LHM Sunday** DVD, and present the **LHM Sunday** talking points.
- ❑ **All:** Meet to set a date and plan the following:
 - Select Feb. 7 or another date that works for your church calendar as your **LHM Sunday** celebration.
 - Order the required quantity of LHM Sunday brochure/giving envelopes from LLL Canada at 1-800-555-6236 or e-mail helpful@lll.ca.
 - Determine if the Ambassador, another volunteer, or the pastor will present the Talking Points and DVD to the congregation.
 - Establish the length of time to present the DVD and/or talking points and determine when to present them.
 - Locate a DVD player for the presenter's use.
 - Consider using the optional sermon, children's message, order of service, and other resources (see page 3 for details).
 - Consider having an information table in the narthex. Display materials can be ordered from www.lhm.org/promote.
 - Decide how to distribute the **LHM Sunday** brochures.
 - Plan to introduce the Ambassador to the congregation before his/her presentation.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Review the promotional videos on the **LHM Sunday** DVD (enclosed in the Ambassador mailing) to see how you can use them in Bible classes, meetings, and other events.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Ask your church secretary to include the bulletin announcements (see page 1) prior to and on **LHM Sunday** wherever appropriate: newsletters, bulletin, church bulletin board, Web site, etc.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Practice your presentation using the talking points provided (right column). Pray for God's blessing upon your presentation.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Lead by example and make your donation using the enclosed brochure/giving envelope.
- ❑ **All:** If your church takes a door collection or writes a check to LHM for the special Sunday, mail it in the **LHM Sunday** brochure/giving envelope provided so your church's gift is properly credited.
- ❑ **Ambassador:** Thank your pastor and other volunteers for their help.
- ❑ **All:** Complete the participation form on page 3!

TALKING POINTS FOR YOUR CHURCH

Welcome to **Lutheran Hour Ministries Sunday**. It is a pleasure to share with you how Lutheran Hour Ministries makes a difference in the lives of people all over the world!

LHM is best known for **The Lutheran Hour**®, the world's longest-running Christ-centered radio program. It is heard weekly by around 600,000 people over more than 900 radio stations and by still more people over XM Satellite Radio, the American Forces Network, and the Internet. Many listeners of **The Lutheran Hour** are not members of LCC or LCMS congregations.

A Spanish-language version of **The Lutheran Hour** called **Para el Camino** was introduced in December 2008; it is available in selected radio markets and also via the Internet.

HM's **Woman to Woman**® with Phyllis Wallace is a broadcast program focusing on issues of faith and life from a woman's perspective. It is aired over nearly 300 radio stations and the Internet.

Beyond radio programming, Lutheran Hour Ministries serves congregations in a variety of ways: providing workshops, tools, and resources for developing effective local outreach strategies; hosting servant trips; supporting men's ministry through the **LHM Men's NetWork**; offering daily and seasonal devotions; and more.

LHM honors its commitment to *Bringing Christ to the Nations—and the Nations to the Church* by supporting **International Ministry Centers** in more than 30 countries— even in places where it is dangerous to proclaim the Gospel. Each **International Ministry Center** is staffed primarily by nationals who understand their cultures and reach out through culturally appropriate means.

There is much more to do. Your support will help LHM reach many more people with the message of salvation through Jesus. Please pray for God's continued blessing on LHM's mission and work.
