

## Korea Vacation Bible & English Camp July—August, 2010

**Dates:** July – August, 2010 – teams can discuss potential dates with LHM. Optimal time is 11 days in country, excluding travel days.

**Individual Budget:** Approx. \$600 – This includes food, lodging, in-country transportation, translators, visas and travel/health insurance. This is an estimated cost and does not include international flights, and is based on a team of 10 people for 11 days.

**Materials for Project:** \$1,500.00 – This includes all materials needed for the camp.



**Vacation Bible & English Camp:** Since its opening in 2003, Lutheran Hour Ministries center in South Korea, known as Korea Lutheran Hour (KLH) has been working to spread the Gospel and to create a youthful vibrancy within the church in South Korea. It does this through music, drama, training, special TV programs and outreach events.

A team is needed to help facilitate a children's vacation Bible – English Camp at Kyunggido Youth Camp – about one hour from Seoul. You will work alongside KLH staff and volunteers in teaching English, singing, and ministering to Korean children in a camp setting.

The vacation Bible and English Camp will be near the capital city of Seoul, and located on the coast of Daebu Island overlooking the West Sea, at the Kyunggido Youth Camp (Gyeonggi-do Youth Center – GYC). This center was opened on July 9, 2001 by the Gyeonggi Provincial Government and is known throughout the nation for its camps teaching children science and health through hands-on programs.

You will learn about Korea through authentic cross-cultural experiences and having fellowship with local Lutherans, and will have the opportunity to share the love of Jesus.
